- Each resident **must hold a DDS or DMD from a CODA-accredited dental school** by the time of enrollment, must be either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, and must be eligible to hold a <u>New Hampshire dental license</u>.
- **NBDE/INBDE** scores are not required at the point of application, but must be submitted prior to matriculation.
- IEF is required; we will accept one from a program completed after dental school such as a specialty program. This can be from a Principal Investigator. One of the PEFs must be from your most recent academic director and/or employer (if applicable).
- \*All applicants must submit official TOEFL scores from a test taken within the past two years and the exam can only be waived if <u>BOTH</u> the bachelor's degree and dental degree were obtained in the United States, Canada, Australia, Ireland, or the United Kingdom. The minimum acceptable overall score is 95, with subcategory score minimums of Reading 21, Listening 17, Speaking 24, and Writing 25. All subcategory score minimums must be satisfied.

<u>NOTE:</u> Please **do not submit** any of the following to HSDM: transcripts, resumes/CVs, letters of recommendation, portfolios, research papers, etc. **All materials submitted to PASS will suffice for the application process.**
