- Masters of Public Health (MPH) degree is required to apply to the Certificate Only program in Dental Public Health but not required for the MMSc or DMSc degrees.
- NBDE/INBDE scores are not required at the point of application, but must be submitted prior to matriculation.
- **NOTE:** Please do not submit any of the following to HSDM: Transcripts, resumes/CVs, letters of recommendation, portfolios, research papers, etc. **All materials submitted to PASS will suffice for the application process.**
- ***Please be aware** that any applicant whose native language is not English is required to submit TOEFL scores from a test taken within the past two years. The TOEFL exam can only be waived if **BOTH** the bachelor's degree and dental degree were obtained in the United States, Canada, Australia, Ireland, or the United Kingdom. **The minimum acceptable overall score is 95, with subcategory score minimums of Reading 21, Listening 17, Speaking 24, and Writing 25. All subcategory score minimums must be satisfied.**
