- Masters of Public Health (MPH) degree is required to apply to the Certificate Only track in Dental Public Health but not required for the MMSc or DMSc degrees.

☐ Official NBDE/INBDE scores (recommended but not required for international candidates)

- **NBDE/INBDE** scores are not required at the point of application, but must be submitted prior to matriculation for domestic applicants.
- IEF is required; we will accept one from a program completed after dental school such as a specialty program. This can be from a Principal Investigator. One of the PEFs must be from your most recent academic director and/or employer (if applicable).
- *Any applicant whose native language is not English is required to submit TOEFL scores from a test taken within the past two years. The TOEFL exam can only be waived if **BOTH** the bachelor's degree and dental degree were obtained in the United States, Canada, Australia, Ireland, or the United Kingdom. The minimum acceptable overall score is 95, with subcategory score minimums of Reading 21, Listening 17, Speaking 24, and Writing 25. All subcategory score minimums must be satisfied.

NOTE: Please **do not submit** any of the following to HSDM: Transcripts, resumes/CVs, letters of recommendation, portfolios, research papers, etc. **All materials submitted to PASS will suffice for the application process.**
