- Masters of Public Health (MPH) degree or its equivalent preferred.
- Each resident **must hold a DDS or DMD from a CODA-accredited dental school** by the time of enrollment, must be either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, must be eligible to hold a [New Hampshire dental license](#).
- **NBDE/INBDE** scores are not required at the point of application, but must be submitted prior to matriculation.
- **IEF** is required; we will accept one from a program completed after dental school such as a specialty program. This can be from a Principal Investigator. One of the **PEFs** must be from your most recent academic director and/or employer (if applicable).
- *All applicants must submit official TOEFL scores from a test taken within the past two years and the exam can only be waived if **BOTH** the bachelor's degree and dental degree were obtained in the United States, Canada, Australia, Ireland, or the United Kingdom. **The minimum acceptable overall score is 95, with subcategory score minimums of Reading 21, Listening 17, Speaking 24, and Writing 25. All subcategory score minimums must be satisfied.**

NOTE: Please **do not submit** any of the following to HSDM: Transcripts, resumes/CVs, letters of recommendation, portfolios, research papers, etc. **All materials submitted to PASS will suffice for the application process.**
