ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This two-month preceptorship program is designed for dentists from the United States and abroad who seek to enhance their general understanding of periodontics, prosthodontics, and implantology at the graduate school level. Participants will engage in intensive summer didactic and clinical courses led by faculty members from the Harvard School of Dental Medicine (HSDM) as well as distinguished scholars and clinicians from various universities worldwide.

In addition to taking fundamental and advanced courses in periodontology, prosthodontics, and implantology, preceptors will have the opportunity to observe clinical cases treated by **HSDM** faculty and residents. Prior to commencing the program, candidates will undergo an interview process to discuss their program goals and expectations.


